

Panel 1: Telling Stories: Hawaii's Scientists, Artists and Activists Respond to Keynote

Content/Abstract: Beth-Ann Kozlovich, former host of *The Conversation* and *Town Square*, HPR, will moderate this four-person panel of community members who live, play and work in Hawaii. She will ask probing questions of, and make intriguing parallels between, the keynote speaker's work in journalism and the work of our residents of Hawaii. Three panelists--scientist Dr Noelani Puniwai, Kamakakuokalani school of Hawaiian Knowledge, whose work combines science research and community knowledge; artist Solomon Enos, whose work includes community art, mental health, and climate change; and student-activist Kawika Pegram who leads Climate Strike Hawaii --will offer their vision of how Hawaii can respond to climate change.
